## **Survey Update | Blood product costs, line 46**

Due to how blood products are charged under the DRG methodology and recognizing that tertiary centers are required to maintain blood and blood components availability across all service lines, the GTC workgroup has excluded the requirement to report blood product costs under Line 46. Centers are welcome to report expenses if desired.

#### Where should the note be on TQIP conference costs?

If the TQIP conference or other national attendance is used to fulfill CE or MOC requirements, report the cost under the appropriate CE/MOC line. For GQIP, a statewide meeting, attendance costs can be noted under line 33 for state and regional involvement.. If TQIP attendance does not meet a specific standard or requirement, do not report the cost.

Which of the two should we base our costing on? 1. Total # records that met NTDB criteria for CY2024 or 2. Total # records that met NTDB criteria admitted to your trauma center for CY2024

- Both calculations are used in specific parts of the survey.
- Use Calculation 1: the total number of records that met NTDB criteria for calendar year 2024, as the primary basis for cost-related calculations. This includes all qualifying patients, regardless of outcome (e.g., deaths, transfers, or non-admissions).
- Calculation 2 is used only in specific parts of the survey. Some formulas, especially those related to inpatient care (e.g., staff providers), are based on admissions and appear starting on line 115. These are often highlighted in green rows to indicate their inpatient-specific nature. The formulas are based on the numbers entered in rows N8 and N10.

## **Survey Updates**

- Line 50 Cardiopulmonary Bypass Equipment:
  - "ECMO" has been added to clarify that ECMO-related costs can be included. Costs reported should be for emergency cardiac surgical care.
- Lines 59-61 Medical Personnel & Services Costs:
  - A new calculation option, D, has been added:
  - "If you employ your physicians, determine net cost (salary + benefits professional fee reimbursement) and estimate the portion attributable to trauma."
  - The previous option D (AAMC database) is now Option E
- Pediatric I and II Center Updates:
  - Line 31 Child Life Administrator Clarified:
    - "Salary & benefits X% % of time on *child life administrative duties* (if position includes other responsibilities)."
  - Line 129 Child Life Program:
    - This line has been added to include child life specialists and associated program costs, using a facility multiplier.
- Calculation Examples Sheet: Examples added from June 13<sup>th</sup> session.
- NEW Blood Product Costs, Line 46: No longer required for readiness costs reporting
