# **GEORGIA TRAUMA COMMISSION UPDATES**

#### 1. PTSF Level IV Consultations

The Pennsylvania Trauma Systems Foundation (PTSF) deployed two teams to facilitate the Level IV consultations the week of October 10th. Five centers were consulted: Polk, Effingham, Meadows, Emmanuel, and Morgan. The feedback has been tremendous, and the amount of education and information provided was priceless for our centers.

PTSF will send out a post-survey to participating centers. Please submit your feedback and let us know if you did not receive a post-survey from PTSF.

The PTSF will attend our November 17th Commission Meeting to provide an aggregate summary of strengths, opportunities, and recommendations from those visits. # **MARCH PAWS**

Dr. Patterson asked Courtney Terwilliger to provide any updates on MARCH PAWS.

The initiative is moving forward. We have our first class scheduled for November 9<sup>th</sup> at Emanuel Medical Center. We have contacted several rural hospitals that border us and reached out to EMS, ER staff, Physicians, and Mid-Levels to participate. We have ordered about \$54,000 of training material. Casey Bridges at Mercer Rural Innovation Center is working on our presentation slides. In January, we hope to facilitate a course in Cordele and, finally, Thomasville to put in the final touches. The long-term goal of the course is to put the didactic material online, which Glenda at the Rural Innovation Center is working with us on.

Dr. Patterson added that HMP Communications are interested in what we are doing and has asked us to put together a report about MARCH PAWS and present it at the EMS World Expo next year. Hopefully, we can present a model for other people in the country.

#### Level III/IV Readiness Cost Survey

Dr. Ashley presented the LIII/IV Readiness Cost Survey at the AAST. Many people are interested in it, and
we are at the forefront of showing what it costs to be a Level III/IV center. We did clarify that this was not
the startup cost but rather a maintenance cost. There could be a follow-up study done in a couple of years.
It would be interesting to see a follow-up on the Level I and II costs with the new standards and the
economic inflation.

#### **ACS Verification Updates**

• Liz Atkins stated the ACS verification requirement may be pushed back further than the current June 30, 2025, deadline due to ACS consult delays. Most centers don't have a consult date yet, but some have dates as soon as September 2023, which will be before the release of the new standards. After a consult, the center has about a year turnaround to schedule their verification visit. It will be challenging to have a verification completed by 2024 or early 2025. We will look at extending the current deadline.
