CALL TO ORDER

Registry Subcommittee

Education Subcommittee

Ms. Moorcones asked for anyone that would like to volunteer with the education opportunities. Ms Moorcones is looking for a course director or contact person for ENPC courses. There was some residual funding for TNCC classes and we are going to host a TNCC instructor course. The course is on it's 8th edition, if you are not IP'd on the 7th edition you will have to complete the 8th edition. November 9th will be when this course is hosted. The TNCC director course will be held around the Atlanta area.

PI Subcommittee

Dr. Hartigan last month had a webinar from Dr Palayr. The presentation will be on the foundation website. PI meetings are the second week of every month.

Pediatric Trauma Subcommittee

Ms. Rowker is the new chair of this committee. They are finalizing the Pediatric Imaging guidelines and implementation of this.

Life Link of Georgia

Ms. Kim Kottemann

Ms. Kottemann reported on Life Link's year end data. Ms. Kottemann reminded the group that she can pull data for anyone who requests it and she mentioned that some have requested data or assisting with data drill down for ACS verifications or re designation visits. Honor Walk, Honor Walls, and Flag Raisings are all ways to celebrate the donor and their family.

Trauma Administrators Group

Please e-mail Ms. Wallace if your administrator will be attending tomorrow's meeting. There are several items that need the administrator input. There will be conference calls in October and December for this group.

Georgia Trauma Commission

Mr. Kunkle reported on the recent reduction to the Commission s' budget by Governor Kemp of 4% for this year and 2% for next year. Ms. Atkins discussed the new PBP requirements that were implemented this year. Ms. Atkins addressed the concerns with the costs of the ACS visit, for this Ms. Atkins confirmed you only have to submit an application. You do not have to remit payment until ACS schedules. Ms. Atkins suggests that even if you submit your application you will not even be in the consult que until next September. When we compile our groups and committees and TQIP participation and work on reimbursement for those. For level 3 and 4 centers there were different PBP requirements.

<u>OEMST</u> Ms. Renee Morgan.

Ms. Morgan reported that a work group will be formed from the GCTE members representing all levels of centers, EMS regions, and disciplines. The group will review the data element list and make recommendations to OEMST as to which fields will be required to be complete if applicable in the record. The proposed data element list will be presented to GCTE to review, make comments, or adopt the final list. OEMST will have the final decision on the adoption of the date elements

being required. The ideal completion date is December 1st. This timeline will allow a month for centers to review the list prior to CY2020 implementation.

Ms. Morgan asks if you have a chance to email Emma Harrington about the app she developed for teen drivers. She deserves congratulations from all of us.

State Office is working on updating all legal documents. There will be a rules change under critical care in trauma centers and clarified that we will adhere to ACS rules. There is a probationary period noted in this clause. Once a center has been reviewed or designated the center is then put on a probationary status and given time to make any noted changes by ACS. All this language is added to make sure we are following the ACS guidelines.

New Business

The subcommittee voted on the next Vice Chair. With 89% of the votes, Ms. Jesse Gibson was nominated.
